

# Boondooma Homestead Caravan & Camping Site Rules

Historic Boondooma Homestead is a heritage listed site. Visitors are requested to treat the site with respect. Maintenance and restoration work is ongoing and visitors are to be mindful of safety requirements in work areas. We hope you enjoy your stay with us.

- Porta potties, cassette toilets or any other similar containers are only to be emptied into the **DUMP POINT** and **NOT EMPTIED INTO THE TOILETS**. Any person violating this condition will be requested to leave the property.
- All vehicles to be parked in accordance to instructions given by the Caravan Parker/Caretaker.
- Smoking is not permitted in any building, or outdoor eating and drinking area. Certain areas of the grounds are designated as '**NO SMOKING**'. Please take note of the signs.
- This complex is totally dependent on tank water for domestic purposes during events. Water may be delivered to the sites depending on availability. Campers can position one/two buckets in front of their site to collect water. Water will not be put into caravan or motor home tanks. Please, do not help yourself to the tank water unless authorised.
- Camp sites must be kept clean and tidy at all times. During events, rubbish bins are placed throughout the property for general rubbish. Please deposit cans and bottles in the special receptacles available for recycling. Bins will be cleared each day.
- People wishing to trade (ie: Stalls) during events will be positioned in designated areas. No trading is to take place from camp sites in the general camping area. Stall holders must have their own public liability insurance.
- Make sure your fresh water tanks are full and your grey and black water tanks are empty before arrival at the property.
- Please arrive at the property with full LP gas bottle/s as no gas is available. Nearest gas & fuel is **47kms** away at **Darr Creek Oasis**.
- **GENERATORS:** Generators should have a noise level not exceeding 68dB. Generators must not disturb your neighbours and must be turned off at 9.00 pm each night. People who wish to run generators outside these conditions must consider relocation to a more appropriate site. Power for CPAP machines is not available during festivals. Campers need to provide an alternate means of even power by 12vlt battery and sinewave inverter, solar or generator.
- **DOGS:** A maximum of two dogs or pets permitted per site. Dogs must be kept under control at all times. All dogs must be on a lead when away from their site. Dogs are prohibited from all food/drinking areas where food and drink are consumed. Dogs are not allowed in the '**BIG TOP**' or any other entertainment areas. '**NO DOGS ALLOWED**' signs will appear in certain parts of the grounds. Dogs must not be a nuisance to other campers. Dogs that have a tendency to snap or bite should be muzzled when away from their camp site. Do not leave dogs in vehicles for long periods of time. Barking and/or howling can become a nuisance to your neighbours. Owners are responsible for cleaning up any '**MESS**' deposited by their pet.
- Any persons who damages any part of the site, removes equipment without permission or enters restricted areas without permission may be asked to leave the property.
- **NO ALCOHOL** to be consumed away from camp sites unless in the designated areas. Excessive alcohol use, abusive language or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated.
