

NOTES FOR ATTENDEES AT Scots in the Bush 2021

AN APPROVED COVID EVENT SAFE PLAN WILL BE IN PLACE. ALL ATTENDEES WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE MINDFUL OF THE SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENT THROUGHOUT THE EVENT. COVID WARDENS WILL BE ON DUTY DURING THE EVENT AND WILL BE MONITORING THE SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENT.

All attendees will be asked a series of questions before checking in. All attendees need to realize if they have any symptoms or are not well, they must not come to the event.

EARLY ARRIVALS: Patrons arriving prior to Wednesday 18th August will pay \$5 per person per night on arrival at the gate.

Facilities: Portable toilets will be placed throughout the camping areas. A dump point is available on the grounds. However campers are asked to arrive at the grounds with empty black and grey water tanks. Please arrive with water tanks full. Showers are not available to campers. Potable water will be delivered to camp sites depending on availability. Place one or two buckets at the front of your site and they will be filled. Water will not be placed into caravans, campers or motor homes.

Fires: A small fire is permitted as long as it is in a container and is off the ground. Check with your neighbour before lighting a fire. Ashes must be disposed of in the ash drums placed throughout the camping area.

Pets: Pets are allowed. They must be on a leash at all times. There will be areas where pets are not allowed. Pet owners must look for signs showing no go areas for pets. Pets will not be allowed in the entertainment, dining or bar areas.

REFUNDS: A full refund will be available if the event is cancelled because of enforced COVID 19 conditions. Anyone wishing to obtain a refund for any other reason, will have to apply for the refund by email info@boondoomahomestead.org.au for the attention of the Secretary. If the refund is approved, the amount of the refund will be the ticketed price less the booking fee. Refunds will not be available for early departure from the event.

CARAVAN GROUPS AND OTHER GROUPS: Groups are most welcome at the event and the parking attendants will do their very best to park members of each group together. Each group must nominate a representative who will contact the Caretaker 07 4168 0159 or Pattie brown on 0408070769 with the number of sites required for the group. Each member of the group will need to go to the web <https://www.boondoomahomestead.org.au> to buy a ticket. The event will be organized in accordance with the COVID 19 Event Safe Framework. All attendees will be required to adhere to all COVID requirements.

STALL HOLDERS: Stall holders will be required to go to <https://boondoomahomestead.org.au> to buy tickets. All stall holders must have their own public liability insurance and have a COVID Industry plan or a COVID check list in place. STALL HOLDERS must telephone the Caretaker on 07 4168 0159 or Pattie brown on 0408070769 to book a stall site.

VOLUNTEERS must register with The Caretaker or Pattie Brown. Each volunteer will be required to supply telephone number and email address and the job allocated. If unsure of the job, please contact the Secretary on 0427364026 to arrange job allocation. All volunteers will be required to take part in the Work safety workshop on the Wednesday morning. Volunteers working in any food areas will be required to do The COVID SAFE FOR DINING IN THROUGH TAFE QUEENSLAND. GO TO <https://tafeqld.edu.au/covid-safe> and then click on **COVID SAFE FOR DINING IN**. Volunteers working in food areas will be required to attend the Food safety workshop at the homestead on the Wednesday morning. It would be good if volunteers could arrive on Wednesday or earlier as many patrons will arrive on the Wednesday. Attendance at these workshops will not be necessary if the volunteer attended the workshops prior to The Spirit of the Bush.

ARTISTS: Performers/Artists will be required to register with the Caretaker on 07 4168 0159 or Pattie Brown on 0408070769 and give time of arrival, mobile number and email address. **Pipe Bands, Ceilidh Bands and other group performers are required to provide a list of performers with names, mobile numbers and email addresses** to the Secretary two weeks before the commencement of the event. All performers will need to check in at the gate with the Check In Qld App. Each person must have down loaded the Check in Qld app. Artists should familiarize themselves with the requirements of any COVID Safe Industry Plan appropriate to their performances.
