

## Boondooma Homestead Caravan & Camping Site Rules

Historic Boondooma Homestead is a heritage listed site. Visitors are requested to treat the site with respect. Maintenance and restoration work is ongoing, and visitors are to be mindful of safety requirements in work areas. We hope you enjoy your stay with us.

- All vehicles to be parked in accordance with instructions given by the Caravan parker/Caretaker
- Smoking is not permitted in any building, or outdoor eating and drinking area. Certain areas of the grounds are designated as “**NO SMOKING**”. Please take note of the signs.
- The complex is completely dependent on tank water for domestic purposes. Water may be delivered to the sites during events depending on available potable water. Campers can place one or two buckets at the front of their site, and they will be filled. **PLEASE ARRIVE WITH FULL WATER TANK/S**
- Camp sites must be always kept clean and tidy. Campers are required to take their rubbish to skip bins located on site. Rubbish bins will be placed around the entertainment area during events. Please deposit cans and bottles in the special receptacles available for recycling.
- People wishing to trade (ie: stalls) during events will be positioned in designated areas. No trading is to take place from camp sites in the general camping area. Stall holders must have their own public liability insurance.
- Please arrive at the property with full LP gas bottle/s as no gas is available. Nearest gas is available at the Durong General Store 23kms away. Fuel is available at the fuel cell at Durong.
- **GENERATORS:** Generators should have a noise level not exceeding 68dB. They must not disturb your neighbours and must be turned off at 9.00 pm. Please consider your neighbours during the day. People who wish to run generators outside these conditions must consider relocation to a more appropriate site. Power for CPAP machines is not available during festivals. Campers need to provide an alternate means of even power by 12vlt battery and sinewave inverter, solar or generator.
- **DOGS.** A maximum of two dogs or pets permitted per site. Dogs must be always kept under control. All dogs must be always on a lead. (**This is a council requirement**). Dogs are prohibited from all food/drinking areas where food and drink are consumed. Dogs are not allowed in the Big Top or any other entertainment areas. “**NO DOGS ALLOWED**” signs will appear in certain parts of the grounds. Dogs must not be a nuisance to other campers. Dogs that have a tendency to snap or bite should be muzzled when away from their camp site. Do not leave dogs in vehicles for long periods of time. Barking and/or howling can become a nuisance to your neighbours. Owners are responsible for cleaning up any ‘**MESS**’ deposited by their pet.
- Any person who damages any part of the site, removes equipment without permission or enters restricted areas without permission may be asked to leave the property.
- **NO ALCOHOL** to be consumed away from camp sites unless in the designated areas. Excessive alcohol use, use of illicit drugs, abusive language or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated. Any offender will be required to leave the complex.
- **FIRE.** A small fire in a container off the ground is allowed on a campsite. The fire must not annoy the neighbours. **All ashes and embers must be placed in the ash drums** placed throughout the area. **AT NO TIME** are they to be discarded outside property limits, on grass or under trees. If a total ban is declared all fires must be extinguished.
- **Porta Potties, cassette toilets or any other similar containers are only to be emptied into the DUMPPPOINT AND NOT EMPTIED INTO THE TOILETS.** Any person violating this condition will be requested to leave the property. Grey water can run onto the ground but must not be disposed of over any boundary fence. Do not let grey water flow into the neighbour’s site. **Please arrive at the homestead with empty black and grey water tanks. DON’T EMPTY CASSETTES INTO DUMP POINT AS SOON AS YOU ARRIVE.**
- A time limit of 2 weeks will apply to your stay at Boondooma Homestead. If a longer stay is required, as in the cast of project workers, an exit time will need to be negotiated with the caretakers.
- Boondooma Homestead property is surrounded by private property and any access to any neighbouring property is prohibited.
